Mission Project Details



PROJECT OVERVIEW: The trip is mainly a humanitarian project. We will share the Gospel through street evangelism, work in orphanages, and feed the hungry. We will also have a medical mission team going this year.

DESCRIPTION OF MISSION: Right in the Heart of Costa Rica is the Capital San Jose. The majority of the country is Catholic. We will go to the center of the city and distribute hundreds of Gospel Tracts to the working class of San Jose. There some will share their personal testimonies on the street. We will also work alongside schools and orphanages

to play and give toys away to children. Our team will also buy groceries for those that live in poverty and take them to their homes. This will open the door for the gospel to be presented. This year we are also excited about adding a medical team to our trip.

LOCAL INFORMATION:**LOCATION DESCRIPTION:**

Costa Rica is in Central America, bordering both the Caribbean Sea and the North Pacific Ocean, between Nicaragua and Panama. The country is slightly smaller than West Virginia. The climate is tropical and subtropical with the dry season of December to April, and a rainy season of May to November. It is cooler in highlands. The terrain is coastal plains separated by rugged mountains including over 100 volcanic cones, of which several are major volcanoes.

WEATHER:

Temperatures fluctuate by elevation, not by season. In the highlands (San Jose, Arenal, Monteverde), temperatures are 75-80 degrees year-round.
