

## MISSION PROJECT: VICTORIA, MEXICO JUNE 1 -6

**AGE GROUP:** Adults (Suitable for families, but no young children)

**APPLICATION & DEPOSIT DEADLINES:**

April 16 - \$100 & application

May 14 - \$200

June 1 - Remainder due

**COSTS:** \$775 Less scholarships.

(Includes air flight, food, housing and mission resources needed including translators.)

Participants may want additional spending money for the open market and snacks at the airport.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** Are available for MBBC members who request funding provided through the generous giving of our membership. Scholarship amounts depend on the number of people participating with aid. The minimum scholarship is expected to be \$325.



### Mission Project Details

**PROJECT OVERVIEW:** To share Christ with the lost, encourage fellow believers and show compassion to those in need. This is primarily done through three projects: Construction of a church, medical missions to the sick & needy and humanitarian aid (feeding and clothing) the poor.



**DESCRIPTION OF MISSION:** Our mission group will fly from Birmingham to Harlingen, TX (southern part of Texas). We will cross the border by vans into Mexico and then travel by bus to Victoria. The regional landscape of Victoria varies widely from mountainous peaks to deserts filled with scrub and cactus.

Although we will be housed in a dorm style home, we will often travel to regional areas to minister to those in great need. The team may be divided into two groups. One group will concentrate on providing
