## DRAWING NEAR TO YOUR EXPERIENCE WITH GOD

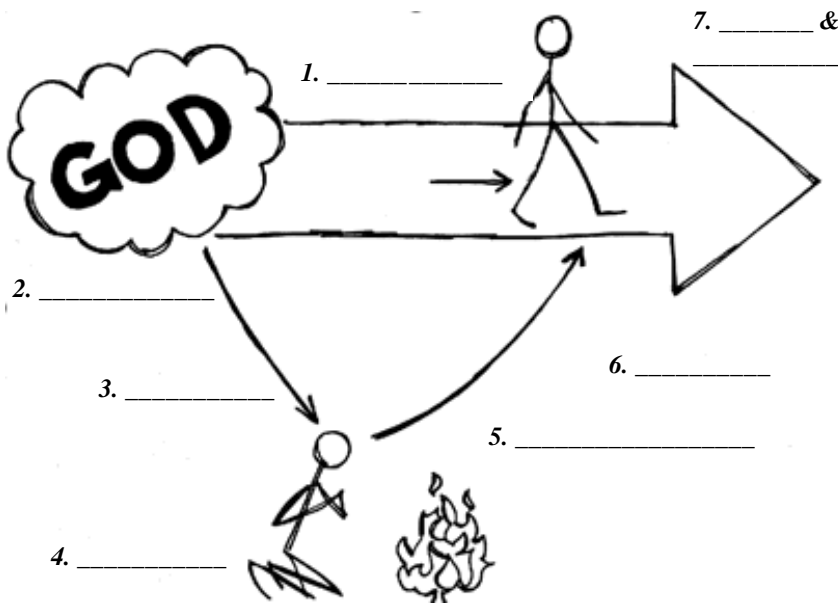
*By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter and chose to suffer with the people of God rather than to enjoy the short-lived pleasure of sin. For he considered reproach for the sake of the Messiah to be greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, since his attention was on the reward. (Hebrews 11:24-26 HCSB)*

**1. GOD IS ALWAYS AT \_\_\_\_\_ AROUND YOU.**

*After a long time, the king of Egypt died. The Israelites groaned because of their difficult labor, and they cried out; and their cry for help ascended to God because of the difficult labor. So God heard their groaning, and He remembered His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. God saw the Israelites, and He took notice. (Exodus 2:23-25 HCSB)*

**2. GOD PURSUES A CONTINUING \_\_\_\_\_  
WITH YOU THAT IS REAL AND PERSONAL.**

Meanwhile Moses was shepherding the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian. He led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. Then the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire within a bush. As Moses looked, he saw that the bush was on fire but was not consumed. So Moses thought: I must go over and look at this remarkable sight. Why isn't the bush burning up? ...God called out to him from the bush, "Moses, Moses!" "Here I am," he answered. Then He continued, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." Moses hid his face because he was afraid to look at God. (Exodus 3:1-4, 6 HCSB)

**3. GOD INVITES YOU TO BECOME INVOLVED WITH HIM IN HIS \_\_\_\_\_.**

*I have come down to rescue them from the power of the Egyptians and to bring them from that land to a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey.... Therefore, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh so that you may lead My people, the Israelites, out of Egypt.* (Exodus 3:8, 10 HCSB)

**4. GOD SPEAKS BY THE \_\_\_\_\_ THROUGH THE BIBLE, PRAYER, CIRCUMSTANCES, AND THE CHURCH TO REVEAL HIMSELF, HIS PURPOSES AND HIS WAYS.**

**5. GOD'S INVITATION FOR YOU TO WORK WITH HIM ALWAYS LEADS YOU TO A \_\_\_\_\_ OF BELIEF THAT REQUIRES FAITH AND ACTION.**

*But Moses asked God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and that I should bring the Israelites out of Egypt?"* (Exodus 3:11 HCSB)

**6. YOU MUST MAKE \_\_\_\_\_ IN YOUR LIFE TO JOIN GOD IN WHAT HE IS DOING.**

*Now in Midian the LORD told Moses, "Return to Egypt, for all the men who wanted to kill you are dead." So Moses took his wife and sons, put them on a donkey, and set out for the land of Egypt. And Moses took God's staff in his hand.* (Exodus 4:19-20 HCSB)

**7. YOU COME TO KNOW GOD BY EXPERIENCE AS YOU \_\_\_\_\_ HIM AND HE ACCOMPLISHES HIS WORK THROUGH YOU.**

*Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea. The LORD drove the sea [back] with a powerful east wind all that night and turned the sea into dry land. So the waters were divided, and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with the waters [like] a wall to them on their right and their left.* (Exodus 14:21-22 HCSB)
