1. I CHOOSE TO REMAIN _____ FOR GOD

2. I CHOOSE TO BE A PERSON OF _____

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth. (1 John 4:7, 3:18 NASB)

3. I CHOOSE TO BE AWARE OF THE CONSTANT _____ OF GOD

I will never leave you or forsake you. (Hebrews 13:5b HCSB)

4. I CHOOSE TO _____ GOD'S WORD

All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work. (2 Timothy 3:16-17 HCSB)

5. I CHOOSE TO _____ MORE ON OTHERS THAN MYSELF

Do nothing out of rivalry or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves. Everyone should look out not [only] for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. (Philippians 2:3-4 HCSB)

6. I CHOOSE TO GROW _____ WITH OTHERS AT MEADOWBROOK

Let us think of one another and how we can encourage each other to love and do good deeds. And let us not hold aloof from our church meetings, as some do. Let us do all we can to help one another's faith, and this the more earnestly as we see the final day drawing ever nearer. (Hebrews 10:24-25 Phillips NT)

7. I CHOOSE TO BE _____ IN MY FAITH

Train yourself in godliness, for, the training of the body has a limited benefit, but godliness is beneficial in every way, since it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come. (1 Timothy 4:7b-8 HCSB)

8. I CHOOSE TO _____ SIN

Wash away my guilt, and cleanse me from my sin. For I am conscious of my rebellion, and my sin is always before me. Against You—You alone—I have sinned and done this evil in Your sight. (Psalm 51:204 HCSB)

9. I CHOOSE TO QUICKLY _____ OTHERS

10. I CHOOSE TO BE _____ ON HEAVEN AND JESUS
